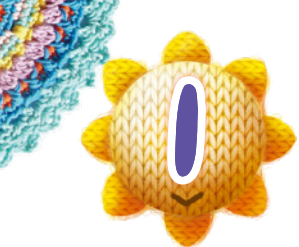

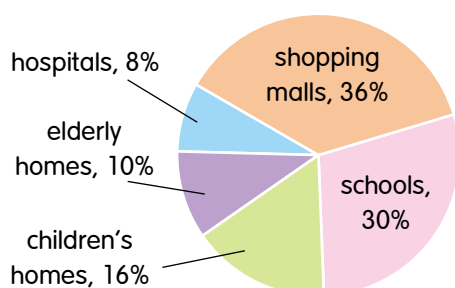
Dear members,
