Get to Know

Comparatives and Superlatives: short adjectives



- We use **comparative adjectives** to compare two people or things.
- We can form the comparatives by adding **'-er'** to **short adjectives**.

Simon is **taller** **than** Fiona.

Fiona is **shorter** **than** Simon.

↑ Add 'than' after comparative adjectives.

- We use **superlative adjectives** to compare three or more people or things.
- We can form the superlatives by adding **'-est'** to **short adjectives**.

Jacky is **the** **tallest**.

Daisy is **the** **shortest**.

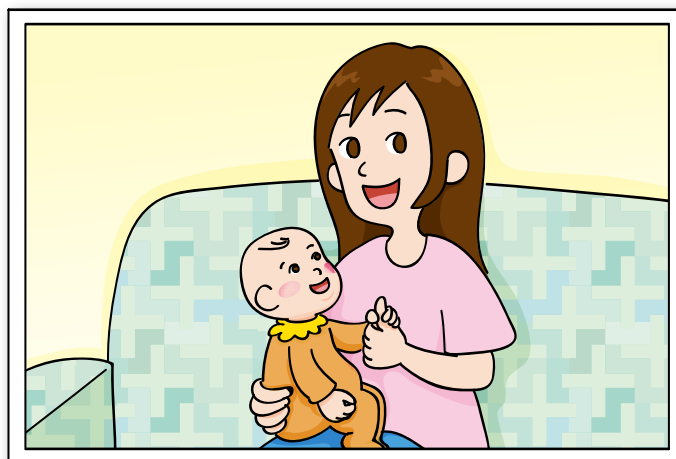
↑ Add 'the' before superlative adjectives.
