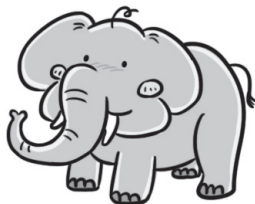
# Comparatives and superlatives

## Common Mistakes

- ✗ Between Joe and Sam, Sam is the tallest.
- ✓ Between Joe and Sam, Sam is taller.

We do not use superlatives to compare only 2 people/things.

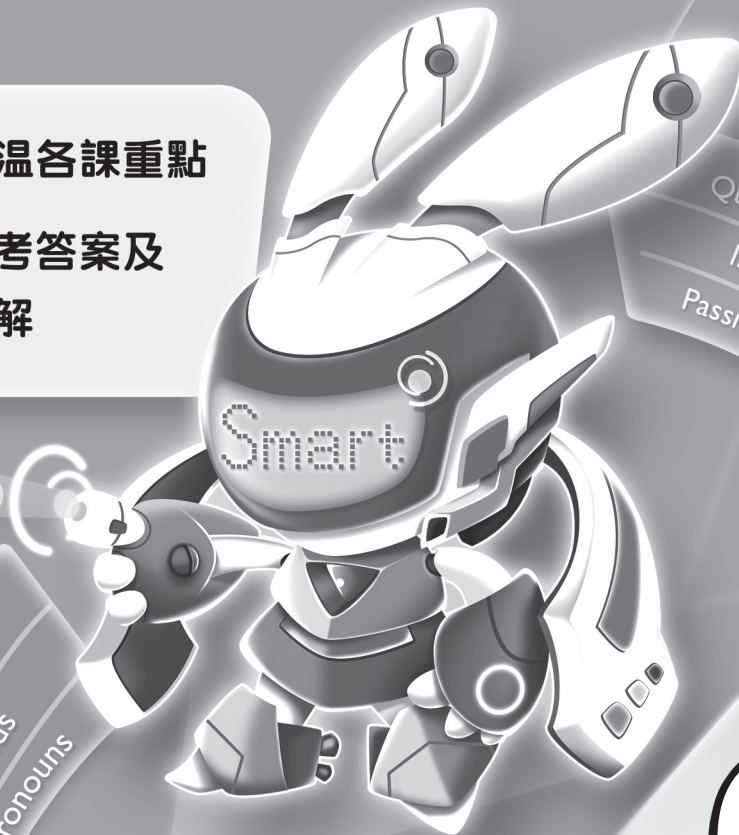
