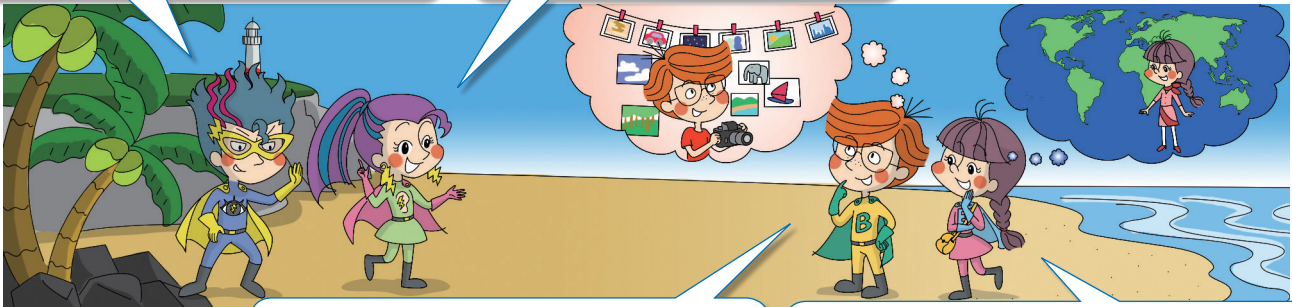


First conditional sentences

Emma and Bruce arrived on Legend Island. They are meeting with Chase and Faye, the famous superhero duo.

Welcome to Legend Island.
We are superheroes.

What do you want to be
when you grow up?



I'll take many photos
if I become a photographer.

If I become a flight attendant,
I'll travel the world.

We use 'If ... will ...' to talk about things that have a good chance of happening.

Pattern 1 – start the sentence with 'if'

- future condition (**simple present**)
- This has to happen first. →

If I become a flight attendant,
I will travel the world.

- future result (**future tense**)
- Then this will happen. ←

Pattern 2 – put 'if' in the middle

- future result (**future tense**)
- This will happen. ←

I will take many photos
if I become a photographer.

- future condition (**simple present**)
- If this happens first. →
